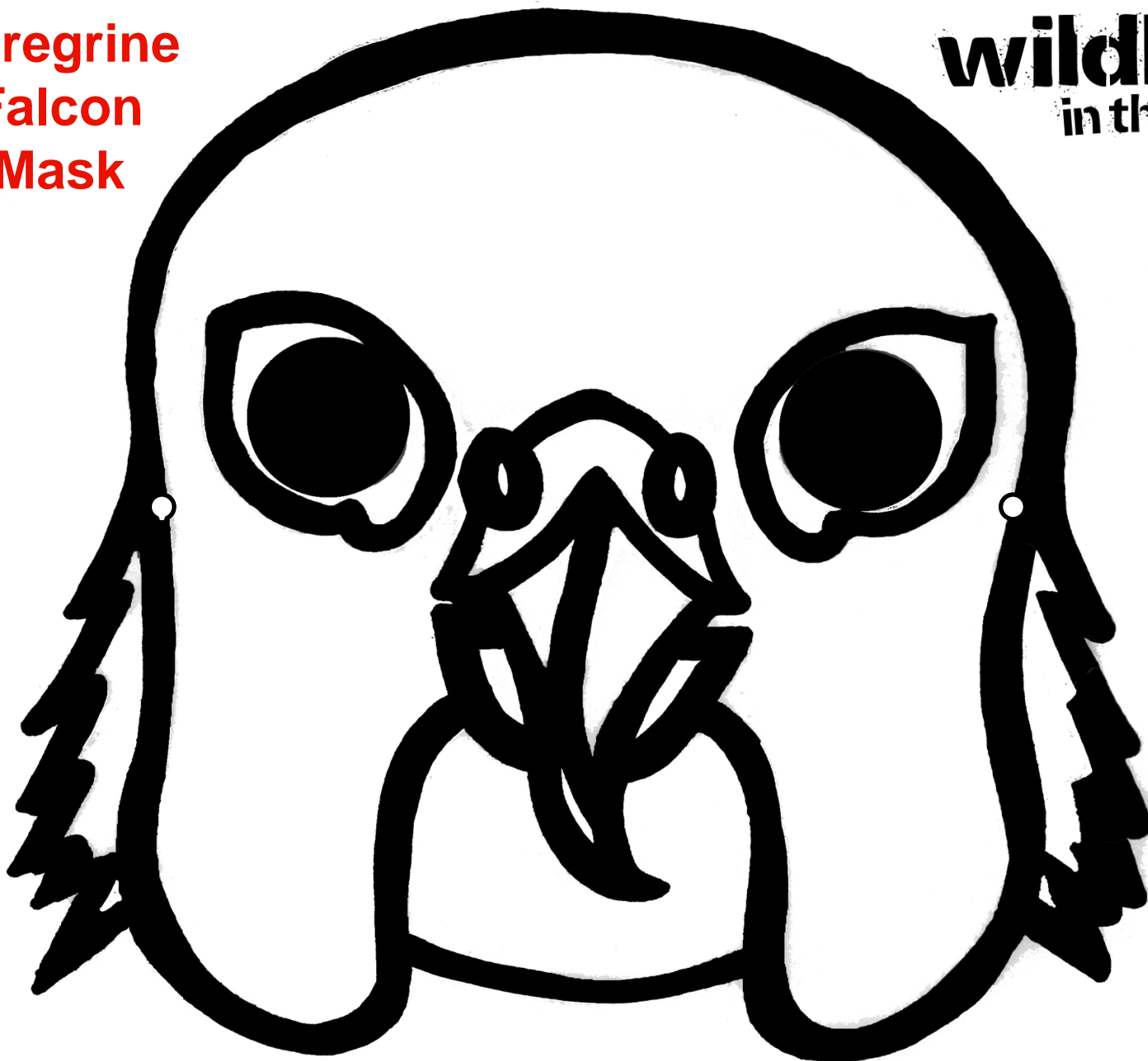


# Peregrine Falcon Mask

1. Print Mrs Peregrine mask onto an A4 sheet of card or thick paper.
2. Using your crayons colour her in.
3. Carefully cut her out. Don't forget to cut holes for the eyes too, so you can see!
4. Put a tiny hole on each side of the peregrine's face. Cut 2 pieces of string and knot around each hole.
5. Put on the mask by tying the two pieces of string around your head. Now you're ready to wear the mask!
